# New \$465 Million Heart Pavilion and Campus Expansion at Lankenau Medical Center to Open on July 25

The signature result of Lankenau Medical Center's \$465 million Master Facility Project—the Heart Pavilion at Lankenau Medical Center — will officially open its doors on July 25. The five-story, 274,000-square foot medical facility was designed to deliver world-class medical care to the region.

The grand opening will mark the official introduction of the cornerstone of the new Heart Pavilion - The Lankenau Heart Institute - which will serve as destination for advanced, personalized, high-quality cardiovascular care. The Lankenau Heart Institute's world-class cardiologists, cardiovascular surgeons and subspecialists will be collocated in the building to offer patient-centered care integrating the latest prevention, diagnostic, treatment, rehabilitation and chronic disease management services.
