



Parking and detour information December 9, 2013 – Spring 2014

Lankenau's main hospital entrance (including the circular drive and valet service) will be closed for renovations from Dec. 9, 2013 – Spring 2014. [Please see below for instructions on where to park and which entrance to use during this time.](#)

The Frankel Lobby (interior lobby of the main hospital) will be closed for renovations from Dec. 9, 2013 – Feb. 9, 2014. Foot traffic will be detoured around the lobby until it reopens.



Renovations include a modernized lobby with new front desk area, additional seating and remodeled bathrooms; plus an updated exterior, wider circular driveway and enhanced canopy coverage.

- **Patients/visitors coming to the main hospital:**

This includes patients coming for surgery, Ambulatory Procedure Center (APC), Cath Lab, maternity or NICU, or family/friends visiting an inpatient.

[Park at the Heart Pavilion \(Garage D or valet—same price\), use the Heart Pavilion entrance \(Street Level or Brodsky Bridge Level One\), and follow signs to the main hospital.](#)

- **Patients/visitors coming to the Medical Science Building (MSB):**

This includes patients with appointments at the Cancer Center, Comprehensive Breast Center, Kidney Department, Transitional Care Center (TCC) and other MSB physician offices.

[Park in Garage A and use the Medical Science Building entrance.](#)

- **Patients/visitors coming to any Medical Office Building (MOB East, West, South):**

This includes patients coming for Pre-Admission Testing or appointments in MOB physician offices.

[Park in Garage B and enter through MOB West. If you need to valet park, please use valet services at the Heart Pavilion \(same price as self-parking\), use the Heart Pavilion Street Level entrance, and follow signs to the MOBs.](#)
