COMMUNITY HEALTH AND OUTREACH

Lankenau Medical Center offers multifaceted education and outreach to children and adults in our community. In FY22, Lankenau provided 112 virtual and in-person programs for more than 5,500 students in kindergarten through 9th grade. Lankenau provided 90 adult programs, including seminars, classes and screenings, attended by over 4,000 participants. The Deaver Wellness Farm provided 17 school programs, 13 medical resident rotations and 420 produce deliveries to patients experiencing food insecurity.

MEDICAL EDUCATION

Lankenau has a long tradition of excellence in medical education, and first trained house officers in 1860. Today, 138 residents and fellows participate in nine residency and fellowship programs. Lankenau's residents and fellows represent a diverse group of physicians from more than 10 different countries.

LANKENAU INSTITUTE FOR MEDICAL RESEARCH

Lankenau Institute for Medical Research (LIMR) is a nonprofit biomedical research institute whose mission is to improve human health and well-being through innovative new approaches to medical challenges. LIMR's principal investigators conduct basic, preclinical and translational research, using their findings to explore ways to improve disease detection, diagnosis, treatment and prevention.
