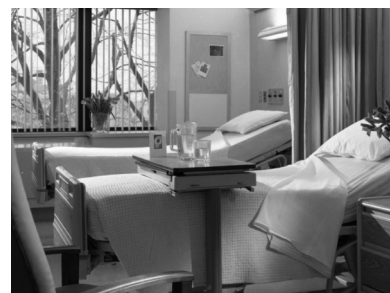

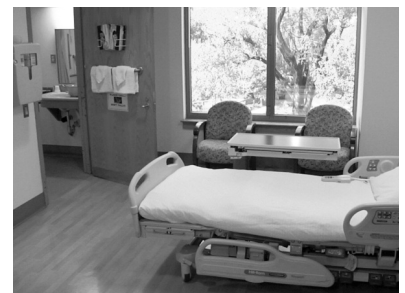

Hospitalist

Hospitalists are physicians who specialize in inpatient medicine and devote 100% of their time to caring for hospitalized patients. They manage all aspects of the patient's hospital stay, including arranging consultations with specialists, ordering tests, treatments and medications. Upon discharge, the patient returns to the care of their physician, who receives a copy of the patient's discharge summary. If a patient does not have a primary care physician, the hospitalist will make an appropriate referral prior to discharge.
