To Schedule: The visits must be scheduled in advance. Please do not call to schedule until <u>after</u> the patient has been transferred to Bryn Mawr Rehab.

Visitors will be required to pass the screening at the main entrance prior to entry. Visitors are not permitted for COVID+ or COVID quarantine patients.

Visitation Guidelines:

- Two visitors per patient, this includes inside or outside the hospital.
- Visitors and patients are to wear tight fitting masks for the entire visit. This includes in the patient's room, throughout the hospital and outside. Visitors may not remove their masks for any reason during the visit, including to eat or drink.
- Visitors and patients should stay at least 6 feet apart as much as possible from each other and from other patients, visitors and staff.

- No visitors age 11 or younger. Visitors age 12-17 require pre-approval to accompany an adult for visit.
- Visitors may not use the restrooms in the patient room.
- All items brought for patients must be given to the nurse, not directly to the patient.

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
